

CAMPER GUIDELINES

(Give this guideline sheet to each camper and worker.)

THINGS TO BRING

Mission Offering (Youth & Children's Camp)	Sunscreen
Bedding (Twin sheets/blankets and pillow)	
Towels/Wash Clothes	Swimsuit (1 piece)
Toothbrush/Toothpaste	Toiletries(Shampoo/Deodorant/Soap)
Shorts/Shirts/Jean	Pen/Pencil/Paper
Bible	Trash bag for wet clothes

THINGS NOT TO BRING

NO FOOD OR DRINKS FROM HOME (snacks provided)
NO fireworks, firearms, knives, or any type of weapons
NO tobacco products of any kind
NO radios, TVs, cell phones, CDs, Ipad's, or Ipad's, any of these items found
will taken form campers and returned at the end of camp.
NO short shorts or two-piece swimsuits (all clothing should be
appropriate for a Christian atmosphere)
NO clothing bearing beer or liquor ads, suggestive or inappropriate
words or pictures (Cooperation = a positive Christian witness)
NO spaghetti straps or other revealing clothing

MISCELLANEOUS POLICIES

NO food or drink is permitted in the pool area
NO rock throwing
NO sitting in or on any vehicles
The Snack Shack will be open at specific times during the week for Youth
Camp and snacks cost \$0.50 each for youth campers.
There will be designated snack times for Children's and Day Camp at no extra
cost to them.
Attendance is required at all scheduled activities unless excused by the
camp nurse.

LEAVING CAMP POLICY

THERE WILL BE NO LEAVING OF CAMP for any reason other than a medical
emergency or a death in the family. Those choosing to leave for any reason other
than that which has been stated will not be allowed to return to camp and all fees will
be forfeited. Exceptions: Parent permission through and approval of Camp Director,
Rare and Necessary only.

PLEASE-NO CALLS TO YOUR CHILDREN WHILE CAMP IS IN SESSION UNLESS IT IS
AN EMERGENCY, VISITS BY PARENTS ARE ENCOURAGED IF THE PARENTS FEEL
THAT A VISIT WILL NOT ENCOURAGE THEIR CAMPER TO GO HOME WITH THEM.
